November 5, 1955 - June 1, 2016

Mr. Gregory C. Adams finished strong after a courageous fight with liver cancer in Sentara Care Plex Hospital, Hampton Va. on June 1, 2016 at the age of 60.

Greg was born on November 5, 1955 in Portchester, New York to Cleo and Nellie Adams. After enlisting in the United States Air Force in 1974, Greg began working for the United States Air Force as a ground radio communications craftsman.

He married Barbara, his best friend in 1975. Over the next 23 years, the couple welcomed two children into their home and Greg set about teaching them photography, enthusiasm for the arts, and compassion for those around them. His children remember him as a fun and loving father who encouraged them to pursue their goals and always supported them in all of their endeavors.

Greg was accomplished at photography and all things media, and was often seen taking spectacular pictures of some of life's most memorable moments. He was a generous and dedicated individual who loved his craft and who was

passionate about making people's memories last a lifetime through photography.
